047/22 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

048/22 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

IT WAS AGREED: that the minutes of the meeting held on the 2nd March 2022 be
approved.

049/22 APPROVE PAYMENTS

IT WAS AGREED that payments/invoices/vouchers to a value of £2,235.32 as presented
by the Clerk, and as listed at appendix 1, be approved.

050/22 ACCOUNTS

IT WAS AGREED: that the bank reconciliations together with receipt and payment
schedules for February 2022, as presented by the Clerk and shown at appendices 2, 3 and

Cllr Tarmey (RMBC Ward Member) reported that Brinsworth Parish Council would take the shelter and that the RMBC was arranging transportation.

057/22 PARISH HALL AND BOWLING PAVILION

Cllr Graham declared an interest in the agenda item relating to the bowling pavilion as she is the secretary of the bowling club.

The Clerk to the Council reported that he had contacted RMBC planning department with regard to pre-application advice.

058/22 FUNFAIR

IT WAS AGREED: that the fee for holding the funfair would be £800.

059/22 CRICKET CLUB

The Clerk to the Council updated members regarding the meeting with the Anston Cricket Club. Amongst other issues it was confirmed that the club had been informed about the Funfair arrangements and that a 50:50 funding for a replacement entrance sign (approximately £195) had been agreed. The issue of land drainage had also been discussed.

IT WAS AGREED: that the fee for hiring part of the recreation ground field for practice sessions would be £55.
